- Using squares as incremental building blocks for floor plan*
- Auto detect sensors to incorporate them into the system with ease*

Method

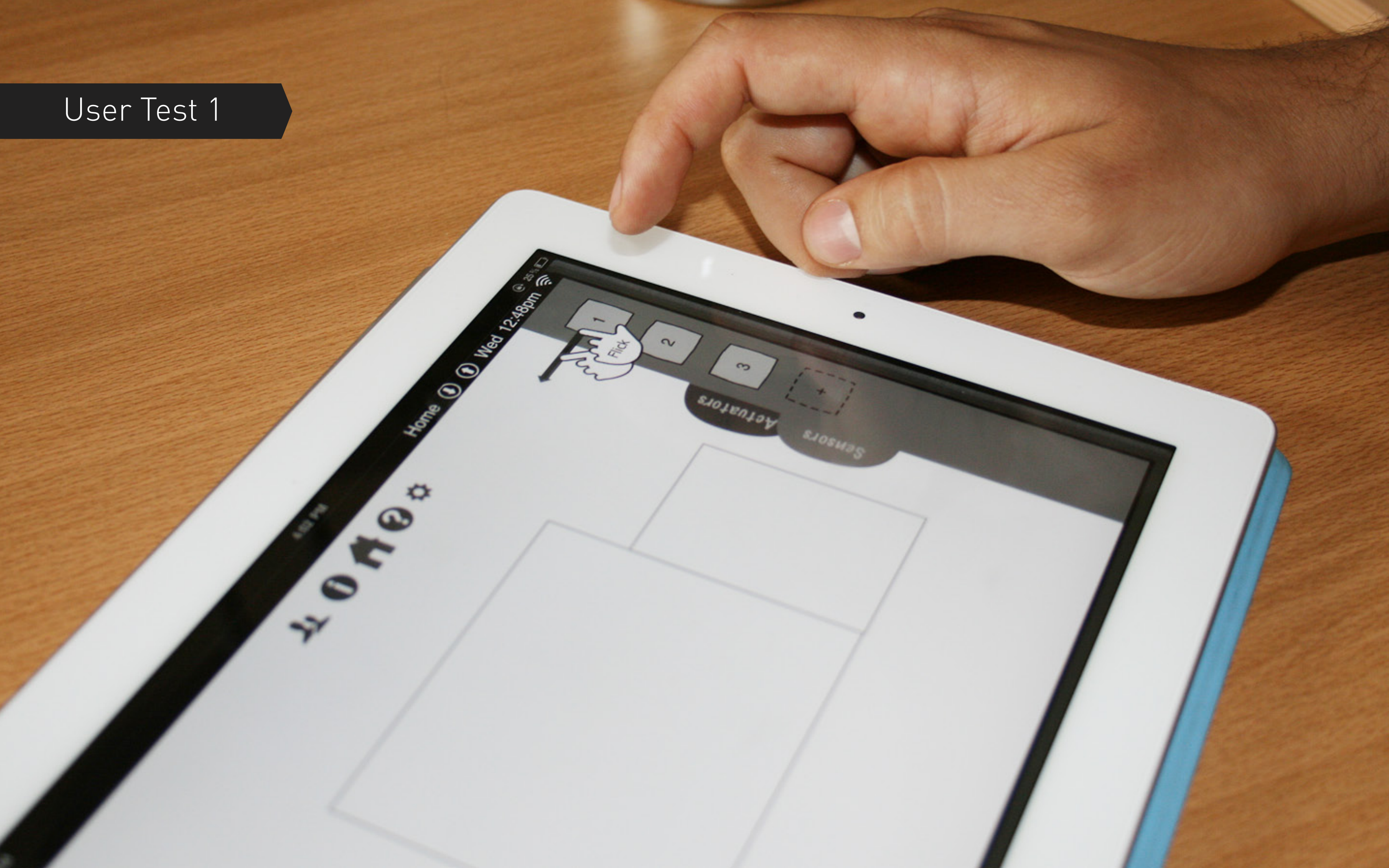
- Brief intro to project
